

COMPOSITION AND PROCEDURE FOR COMPLEMENTARY FEEDING AND DEWORMING OF WILD BOARS

GENERALITIES:



The invention refers to the protection of cynegetic fauna, in particular, of wild boars, and can be used for their disinfestation both in nature and in zoological gardens. The parasitoses are the most frequent diseases affecting wild animals. The extensivity of invasion is up to 75-100%, which causes important economic losses to cynegetic fauna. Elaborating methods of the wild boars disinfestation is an important matter, especially because the wild boars species are final hosts in the development cycle of various parasite species dangerous both for people and domestic animals.

SOLUTION:

The invention consists in simultaneous disinfesting of the wild boars and compensating their physiological necessities by adding briquetted food providing them vitamins, oligo elements and assimilable concentrated minerals during the cold season of the year and the pre-reproductive period in spring. This offers a new qualitative effect and allows ensuring their survival, to enhance their reproductive potential in natural conditions, and to diminish their risk of being captured by predators.

ADVANTAGES:



The result of the invention consists in the enhancement of the therapeutic effect, with 85,5% of wild boars being cured. The method allows maintaining the numbers of wild boars and their potential of reproduction in nature. Additionally, this method allows both the food supply and the antiparasitic remedy to be used efficiently and sparingly. The method is costless and does not require much effort, unlike other existing treatment methods which have low antiparasitic efficiency and quite expensive, and therefore indirectly contributes to the spreading of parasites in nature.

IMPLEMENTATION STAGE:

The method is being successfully applied in forestry by the Society of Hunters and Fishermen from Republic of Moldova (Act on Implementation of 31th of January 2020).
