### **Description of the variety.**

The variety was obtained in the “**Al. Ciubotaru**” National Botanical Garden (Institute), by hybridizing the varieties ♀ *Chiper Chery* x ♂ *Ciombe*. It was registered at the State Agency on Intellectual Property of the Republic of Moldova, in order to **be patented:**

**Patent Nr. 201, y. 2016**

Rhizomatous perennial plant. Uniform plants with linear, light green leaves. They grow about 80 cm tall in the flowering stage. It has simple funnel-shaped flowers, wide open, acuminate petal lobes. The diameter of the flower is about 12 cm. Internal petals are pink-reddish with cherry red spots at the base and golden in the center. The external petals are yellow-brick-red, overlaid with dark red. The inflorescence has 7-9 branches, each with 5 flowers. 6-9 year old plants form 20-35 flower stalks. The flowering stage lasts from June till July. It lasts about 60 days.



The variety can grow in sunny and half-shaded areas. It is undemanding towards soil, but prefers rich, well-irrigated substrate. The plants are very resistant to pathogens and pests.

**Use:** for cut flowers in various floral decorations, in landscape planning: flower beds, mixed flower beds, solitary groups, on the banks of water basins; can be promoted as a container plant.
